

## LambPlus Sign-Ups 2018

- For any pedigree sheep breeders, the closing date for joining LambPlus for the 2018 season is today (1<sup>st</sup> December). Sheep Ireland has communicated this date to all existing participants and some new breeders via
  - Letters.
  - Weekly updates (This publication).
  - Text messages.
  - National press.
- The number of participants for the year ahead looks to be on par with last year's numbers, but final numbers will not be known until all LambPlus Sign-Ups are fully processed which will take some time.

# An Opportunity to Highlight your Flock

Last year Sheep Ireland carried out several case studies on how accurately the €uro-Stars can predict the

pregnancy scanning results in performance recording flocks, and the results were extremely encouraging and got a lot of attention on the Sheep Ireland website and social media. You can find these case studies <u>here</u>.

As this is an optional trait to record in 2017 Sheep Ireland is willing to help breeders with recording this trait as much as possible. (Including ewe ID and number of embryos) via their smart phone to <u>query@sheep.ie</u> or record the information online themselves.

Your flock maybe highlighted on the Sheep Ireland website and elsewhere which will be good publicity for you and your flock. Before any results are published Sheep Ireland will seek the breeders permission to do so.


