








- The stats above are compiled with the assistance of DAFM AIM systems.
- → BVD test results continue to be received at ICBF and are being processed accordingly. There have been 1,624,736 results received since January 1<sup>st</sup>, of which 87,400 have come in the last 7 days. Since the beginning of the voluntary phase in 2012, 13,546,234 results have now been received.




Dairy Cow Population by county 2017. Click here for further details.

- ♣ Bull details and inbreeding reports have been sent to participants. All straws should be used in the current season.
- ♣ Inseminations need to be recorded for the purpose of genetic evaluations for male fertility and gestation length.

#### **LambPlus Deadline**

The deadline for entering lambs onto the Sheep Ireland database has now passed. Any lambs entered onto the system from Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> May onwards will not receive €uro-star evaluations this year. For breeders that may have missed the deadline for birth notifying their lambs via the Sheep Ireland website, we would encourage you to contact your relevant breed society to notify them as the web screens for the following breeds are now shut down:

Belclare, Beltex, Galway, Rouge, Texel and Vendeen.

### **CPT 40-Day Weights**

This week we gathered our final 40-day weights from CPT lambs. Over 4,200 ewes and lambs were weighed, BCS, and Dag scored with any incidence of lameness and mastitis recorded also. All of this data was collected via our new Sheep Ireland App which has helped us make the process of collecting this huge amount of data more efficient.


