








- ♣ The stats above are compiled with the assistance of DAFM AIM systems.
- ♣ BVD test results continue to be received at ICBF and are being processed accordingly. There have been 2.05 million results received since January 1<sup>st</sup>, of which 23900 have come in the last 7 days. Since the beginning of the voluntary phase in 2012, 6.99 million results have now been received.

#### 4 Euro-Star Updates

As communicated in last week's update, at the last industry meeting it was agreed that the visual presentation of the beef indexes would be updated.

It was agreed to:

- 1. Remove the terminal index for all females.
- 2. Remove within breed stars for commercial animals (including traits).

#### This week we have:

- (i) Turned off all **Within Breed Stars** for **Commercial** animals, (a commercial animal is a cross bred animal, not a pure bred).
- (ii) Turned off all **Terminal Index** Stars for **ALL females**. We will remove the Index value over the next few months.







In Image 1, 1003 and 1373 no longer have Stars on the **Terminal Index** as they are both females. **LM462** has **Terminal Index** Stars as these stars are available for males only.

1003 is a commercial female/cross bred so she no longer had Within Breed Stars. 1373 and LM462 have Within Breed Stars as they are Purebreds.



In Image 2, the Sample Pedigree Female no longer has Stars on the **Terminal Index**. In Image 3, there is **no difference** to this Sample Pedigree Male as he is a purebred male.

The design and layout of all reports, catalogues, online profiles and the bull search will be updated over the next few months to complement this change.

#### 5 Genetic Evaluations

Dairy genomic evaluations are currently being processed and loaded to the database ahead of the release of the August official run.


