








- The stats above are compiled with the assistance of DAFM AIM systems.
- ♣ BVD test results continue to be received at ICBF and are being processed accordingly. There have been 1,949,000 results received since January 1st, of which 19,000 have come in the last 7 days. Since the beginning of the voluntary phase in 2012 4.61 million results have now been received.

Texel Premier Sale 2014

Last Saturday 9th August we attended the Irish Texel Sheep Societies Premier sale in Blessington, Co. Wicklow. This was a very large sale boasting over 350 entries. Overall the sale had an excellent clearance rate. 100% clearance of the Shearling Ewes, 50% for ewe lambs and an 83% clearance average across the shearling and ram lamb sections. €uroStar demand

Demand for stars was evident on the day, with high starred animals attracting more bids and easier sales throughout the day. The accuracy% attached to many of the evaluations was another noticeable aspect of the sale. It is clear the accuracies being achieved across the Texel breed are improving year on year. The average accuracy for ram lambs across the sale are higher than that in any other breed at present, helped by the large number of breeders involved in the LambPlus programme. Hopefully this growth in accuracy will continue, for the benefit of commercial farmers using Texel rams. See below for some images from the sale.

CPT Update

This week we carried out Ultrasound scanning on a large number of commercial lambs across our CPT flocks. A liveweight is also collected at this point. This data is invaluable to our Indices. While collecting this data, we also recorded a visual score for each lamb scanned. Each lamb was scored from 1-5 based on their visual appearance and condition. This type of visual scoring is employed by the ICBF in the beef genetic indexes and they have proven to be extremely beneficial. There are major benefits from a practical point of view also, as they are very easy measurements to collect on farm. We will analyse the data that has been collected and see if this type of measurement would have a role to play across our pedigree recording flocks. The more new traits that we can include in our evaluation, the more progress we can make in terms of accuracy and ultimately genetic progress.


